

**SUZUKI CHARTER SCHOOL
PROVINCIAL ACHIEVEMENT EXAMINATION RESULTS 2017**

Suzuki Charter School students demonstrated outstanding achievement on the June 2017 Provincial Achievement Tests. A total of 44 Grade 6 students wrote English Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies and Science exams.

In **ALL** four exams Suzuki students attained a very high rate of **EXCELLENCE** (attainment of a grade of at least 80%) that is significantly higher than their provincial counterparts. The percentage of Suzuki students attaining the excellence rating ranged between 15.9% and 52.3% compared to provincial averages between 12.6% and 29.0%,

Students are to be congratulated for their focus on learning as demonstrated by these outstanding scores. Parents and teachers are also to be congratulated for their role in supporting students to be well prepared to meet high expectations for success as demonstrated in their achievement results.
